#### **Description:**

The Niagara™ Medium Duty Scrubbing Sponge 74N is a dual function cleaning pad. The scrub sponge combines a general purpose scouring pad laminated to an absorbent cellulosic sponge.

#### **Special Features:**

Scouring Side:

- Non-rusting and resilient high quality synthetic fibers to provide pad durability and long lasting usage.
- Abrasive minerals selected to provide remarkable scouring for common cleaning jobs.
- Abrasive mineral particles evenly distributed throughout the scouring pad to help ensure effective, consistent, and long lasting performance throughout the life of the pad.
- High quality bonding resin system designed to provide resistance to degradation from exposure to hot water, detergents and normal cleaning liquids.

# Applications:

Test in an inconspicuous area prior to use.

Scouring side can be used for cleaning, scouring, and scrubbing cookware, kitchen utensils and equipment, kitchen surfaces, baked-on food, floors, stairways, walls, railings, desks, counters and maintenance equipment.

Sponge side can be used for wiping up spills and messes or carry cleaning solutions to the work surface.

#### Packaging:

74N: 20 Pads/Case 74NCC: 10 Pads/Pack, 6 Packs/Case

#### **General Use Directions:**

The scrub sponge can be used wet or dry.

- Hold scrub sponge with one hand.
- Place either side of the scrub sponge against the surface to be cleaned, apply desired pressure and scrub or wipe the area in circular motion.
- Rinse off scrubbed areas with clean water or wipe off with clean sponge.
- 4. Clean scrub sponge as necessary after use.

#### **Pad Cleaning Instructions:**

**Note:** Sponge does not require bleaching.

Cleaning scrub sponge provides multiple uses. Used and/or wornout scrub sponges can be disposed of in regular kitchen trash.

The scrub sponge can be rinsed with warm or hot water or soaked in a cleaning solution to dissolve caked-on soil and grease.

Scrub Sponge Cleaning by Hand

- Spray or rinse off excess food debris from scrub sponge using a dish sprayer or sink faucet.
- Wash the scrub sponge in soapy water to remove any remaining food debris and grease. Remove embedded food debris from scrub sponge by hand.
- Rinse scrub sponge with clean water. Make sure no food debris is left on the pad. Squeeze excess water from the scrub sponge and allow to air dry.

If desired, soak scrub sponge in sanitizer solution. After soaking, squeeze excess solution from the scrub sponge, rinse and allow to air dry. Scrub Sponge Cleaning by Dishwasher

- Spray off or rinse excess food debris from scrub sponge using dish sprayer or sink faucet. Remove stubborn food debris such as cheese from scrub sponge by hand.
- Place scrub sponge in dishwasher and make sure both sides of the pad are exposed to washing.

After washing, take scrub sponge out of dishwasher and allow to air dry.
